2020 Annual Report



The Mid Missouri Chapter Annual Report for 2020 will be published in June. In the report you'll learn how the chapter survived the year despite the challenges faced due to COVID19. Our chapter was able to adjust plans quickly in order to offer free virtual events in place of the typical in-person format for network programs, but we were unable to offer any paid workshops or events. You'll see that impact in the profit and loss section. Some highlights from the report include:

- Membership dropped by 18 for a total of 224 members at the end of 2020
- 25 events were offered during 2020, with nearly 400 attendees
- 25 PDUs were offered
- Member survey was conducted to get a pulse on readiness for in-person events and interest in pursuing the annual conference plans, and decisions were made based on the survey results
