TRUST BREAKERS VS TRUST MAKERS ON PROJECTS

On December 11th from 6:30 PM to 8:30 PM, PMI KC Mid America chapter, will be hosting a workshop in which participants will identify primary causes of broken trust they have observed - or been a part of on project teams during their careers. A three-step process for addressing trust violations will be presented and applied to real-life situations on project teams or other types of teams. Then the four core behaviors that demonstrate trustworthiness will be identified and discussed: 1) Communicating with honesty and transparency, 2) Listening more than one speaks, 3) Showing appreciation for the contributions of others, and 4) Soliciting and acting on feedback from others.



Building trust is a process. Trust results from consistent and predictable interaction over time.
